Headteacher's Message

As you know, today we are losing **Mrs Marks** (Miss Simmonds). She is moving on to do her training to become a Paediatric Nurse. Mrs Marks will be replaced by Miss Buckley when we return to school after half term.

On Tuesday evening I attended the Tenants and Residents meeting at Saltwells EDC regarding the **MUGA** on the school field. I'm pleased to say that the school and Local Authority have been able to reorganise the Academy land conversion to **NOT include** the games area and that section of the field. The local council have supported this decision, so all being well the MUGA will continue to be a resource that is open to the local community and will be owned and maintained by Dudley Council. It was never the position of the school to take ownership of the MUGA until it was insisted upon by the LA, so this is a very pleasing result for all concerned.
