#### Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents,

Well, we are now in the run up to Christmas, so I thought I would update you on a few key events coming up.

Firstly, please remember that this year the Upper School Production (Y4, 5, 6) is in December NOT July as has been the case in the past. We are trialling it at Christmas to give Year 6 a more structured end to their time at Netherbrook and to ensure that they can fully benefit from the transition programmes that the local High Schools organise in the summer.
