

Dear Parents/Carers,

Well, we are nearly there. Just one week to go before the start of the long summer holidays. It has been a great year again and thank you all for your ongoing support.

Next year we will be increasing our **communication** with parents through a variety of means. We feel that it is important that parents have a greater knowledge of what their child is doing in school and hopefully we can let you know more quickly through texts and messages home when your child has done something great in school.

Well done to Year 6 for a fantastic trip to **Drayton Manor** this week. We had a great day and the children's behaviour was impeccable throughout. It is their Leavers Service next Thursday at 2.00pm which will be finished off by launching balloons with the children's' wishes for their future—I hope that they all come true.

Today you will be receiving your child's end of year school report. Please take some time to read it and come in on Monday for our Open Evening, to have a chat with the teachers if you have any questions. You can have a look through the books too. Reception, Year 1, Year2 and Year 6 will also have their statutory test results included in their reports today too.

As usual, I have had the pleasure of reading and signing all of the children's reports this year and they really are wonderful to read. So many children have made such great progress and achieved many personal triumphs. Hopefully you will be pleased. However, please remember that reports are written mainly for **parents** and as such they are honest about some issues which may need to be addressed next year. Please have a chat with your child about their report and ensure that they know to work hard on any areas for development mentioned next year.

We have noticed that many pupil's attendance for this year is below the 95% target issued by the Government. As such, next year we will be adopting a similar policy to many other schools locally. This will mean that if your child has *more* than 7 days absence during the academic year, you will need to provide some form of medical evidence that they are ill, otherwise absences will be recorded as unauthorised. We are also having an increasing number of children arrive late at the school office. PLEASE make sure that children arrive promptly, no later than 8.55am. Again, we will be tightening up on this next year and persistent lateness will also be recorded as unauthorised.
