Dear Parents,

We are now building up to a very busy festive season. Please remember that the **Upper School Production** will be at Christmas this year NOT in the summer. Can I please remind parents that you are responsible for the **conduct and behaviour of your children** (those attending Netherbrook and those that don't) before and after school. Please do not allow any children to play on the KS2 climbing frame, disturb resources in the Early Years playground or the outdoor classroom outside the Year 1 classes.

The new **exercise equipment** for both playgrounds has been ordered and should be installed in the next few weeks.
