Dear Parents and Carers,

Just a few reminders this week about forthcoming events. Don't forget your advent calendars tomorrow! ☺

Next week sees our discos. We are trialling a different approach this year and so the discos will be on three different nights. Tickets are still available from the school office but please note all discos start and finish at the same time. 3.30pm – 4.40pm. Pupils may wear their disco clothes to school on their disco day but these *must be sensible and school appropriate and make up should not be worn.*

Early Years and Lower School are busy preparing for their two productions so that is exciting. Please take a note of the dates and come along to support the children if you can.

Can I remind parents once again that no pupils should be left unsupervised before school starts. The gates open at 8.30am but staff supervision only starts at 8.45am. If you choose to leave your child unattended during these times and they leave the site without anyone's knowledge then it will not be until we contact parents via phone at 9.15am to find out why a child is absent that any alert can be raised or action taken. If you choose to drop your child off and leave or they walk to school and arrive before 8.45am then this is **ENTIRELY** at parents' risk.

As I mentioned a few weeks ago we have now had a pedestrian walkway painted on the front car park and the small gate has been opened. From Monday 3rd December the main school car park gates will close at 8.15am and will not be opened again until 3.30pm. The pedestrian gate will remain open until we are able to install entry/exit systems. Please bear this in mind from Monday when dropping children off or collecting them during the school day. Parking is easier on Bristol Road. Can I also please remind all parents and carers not to block the road, park illegally or block residents drive ways as this can put lives at risk.

There was an accident on Cradley Road this morning involving an older child at High School being knocked over. I have reminded pupils in assembly about taking care when crossing roads – it would be great if parents could follow this up at home.
