As part of our ongoing efforts to make our safeguarding arrangements securely outstanding we will be adapting the entrance to the front car park soon. We are awaiting line markings to be painted from the pedestrian gate to the front doors. Once this pedestrian footpath is complete we will be closing the front gates of the school throughout the day and the only access will be on foot through the pedestrian gate next to the car park entrance. In due course both the pedestrian and vehicular gates will have an entry/exit intercom fitted and will be fully automated, access to the entire site will be with permission only. Although we have never had an issue with safety on the front car park there is always the potential for this to occur and the safety and excellent safeguarding of our pupils is our main priority. There will also be a new disabled parking pay added to the car park in front of the main doors. Please bear with us whilst these changes are being made and please remember that they are designed to increase safety for visitors and our children. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

Can I also please politely ask parents not to smoke around the gates to school on the public foot paths. We have a number of pupils with very bad asthma which can be specifically triggered by inhaling secondary cigarette smoke. Obviously, we can't enforce this rule as it is the public highway but it would be very much appreciated if parents could keep any smoking away from the main entrances around the site. Thank you.
